- ★ **Community Support:** Local communities became more involved in the educational process, providing additional resources and support for schools.

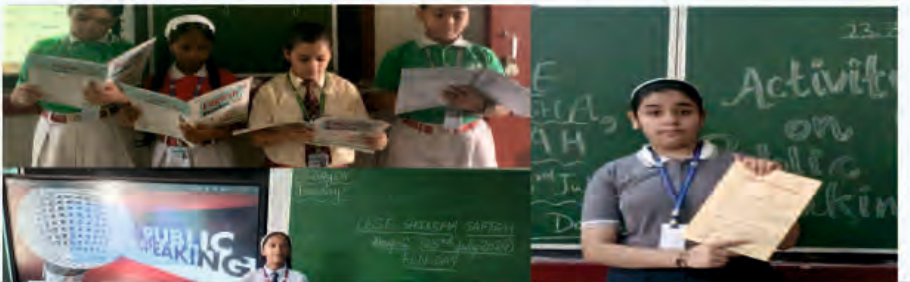
Challenges Faced

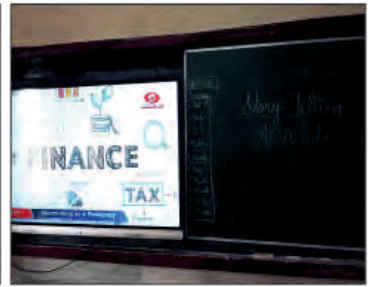
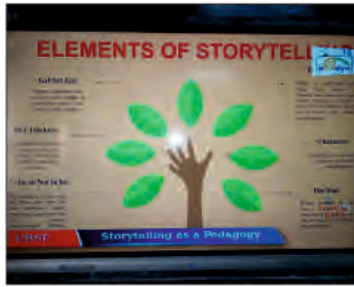
SKILL DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES

The Four Rules of Shared Inquiry Discussion:

1. Only those who have read/heard the selection may take part in discussion. Participants who have not read the selection cannot support their opinions with evidence from the text, nor can they bring a knowledge of the text to bear on the opinions of others.
2. Discussion is restricted to the selection that everyone has read. This rule gives everyone an equal chance to contribute, because it limits discussion to a selection that all participants are familiar with and have before them. Acknowledging the Active Volunteers

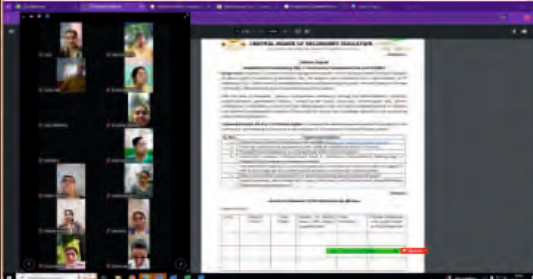

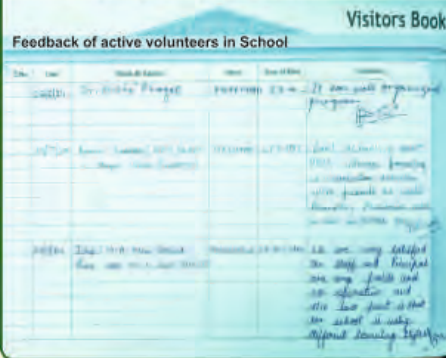
SPREADING AWARENESS ON SOCIAL MEDIA
