■ नई दिल्ली : आपके बच्चों को गैल्स या 'सोशल मीडिया' का चरम मेटली और इमोशनली बड़े नुकसान का शिकार बना सकता है। ऐसा इसलिए कि (NCRB) नेशनल ब्रह्म रिपोर्ट ब्यूरो की हालिया रिपोर्ट में पाया गया कि साइबर अपराध के शिकार होने वाले बच्चों के आंकड़ों में 32 फीसदी इजाफा हुआ है। कुछ समय

पहले एक 'जर्नी-मनी' कंप्यूटर सिम्युलेशन कंपनी ने रिपोर्ट जारी कर कहा कि 85% भारतीय बच्चे साइबर बुलीइंग का शिकार हो रहे हैं। आप भी सतर्क रहें। कहीं ऐसा न हो कि आपकी अनदेखी से आपका बच्चा 'साइबर बुलीइंग' या 'ऑनलाइन रैगिंग' के जाल में फँस जाए। साइबर पुलिस ऑफिसर का कहना है कि बच्चे सोशल मीडिया पर अकाउंट बना लेते हैं, लेकिन सिम्युलेशन के लिखाज से सही मैनेज नहीं कर पाते। जिसका फायदा स्कैमर्स उठाते लगे हैं। सबसे ज्यादा बुलीइंग, फेक प्रोफाइल से दोस्ती कर सेक्सुअली हैरेसमेंट, चैटिंग और अन्य ऑनलाइन खतरों का शिकार होते हैं। जो बच्चों को मेटली और इमोशनली टॉर्चर करते हैं।

व्या है साइबर बुलीइंग: साइबर बुलीइंग एक तरह का टॉर्चर है, जो इंटरनेट या अन्य डिजिटल प्लेटफॉर्म के जरिए किया जाता है। इसमें कोई अनजान या खुप किसी को मेसेज, चैट या ईमेल के जरिए मानसिक, भावनात्मक रूप से चोट पहुंचाता है। यह अपमानजनक टिप्पणियाँ, धमकियाँ, अफवाहें फैलाना या नीचा दिखाकर मानसिक तनाव में डालना होता है। इसके कारण डिप्रेशन, एंजाइटी और स्ट्रूसहाड जैसे विचार भी आ सकते हैं।

'पैरेंट्स' से बुना जाता है बुलीइंग का जाल: एक रिपोर्ट के मुताबिक, 91% बच्चे और टीनेजर्स फेसबुक पर साइबर बुलीइंग का शिकार होते हैं। 24.5% बच्चे X पर साइबर बुलीइंग का शिकार होते हैं। 72% लड़कियों को अनवॉन्टेड सेक्सुअल कंटेंट मिला है। बुलीइंग के शिकार नाबालिगों ने बताया कि इससे उनकी सहेल और स्कूल वर्क पर नकारात्मक प्रभाव पड़ता है।

बताएं कि उनकी एक जरा सी गलती जेल पहुंचा सकती है। उनसे पूछा कि क्या वे अपने मा-बाप को जेल में देखना चाहते हैं। क्योंकि इंटरनेट कनेक्शन पैरेंट्स के नाम से होता है।

- वर्युअल दुनिया में अनजान दोस्ती से बचें।
- कभी भी अपनी लोकेशन शेयर ना करें।

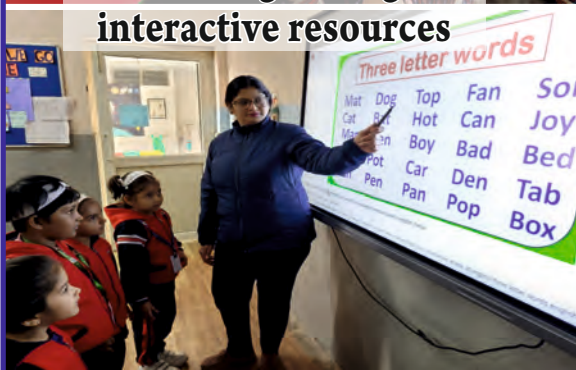

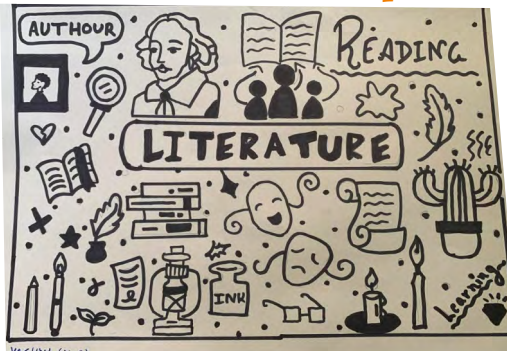

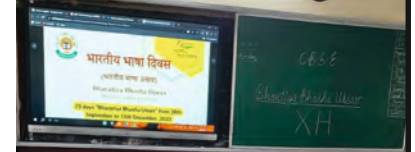
